TRAINING COURSES SPONSORED BY THE NEF

A number of employers in different sectors are proposing to recruit Mauritian people abroad, on cruise ship and locally. The objective of the training courses is to professionalize the sectors where there is a high demand of labour.

The training will be provided by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD). Applications are therefore invited from Mauritians who are interested in the training courses below. The training including practical session will be on a part time basis over a period of two months on average.
