TRAINING COURSES SPONSORED BY THE NEF

The Training and Placement Unit aims to develop new vocational training to enable NEF beneficiaries and unemployed registered with NEF to acquire technical skills to enable them to find a job on the local market through the Training and Placement Programme or abroad through the Circular Migration Programme. Where ever possible NEF ensures the placement of its trainees so that they obtain the required practical experience to enhance their employability.

Applications are therefore invited from UNEMPLOYED Mauritians who are interested in the training courses below. The training will be provided by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD). The training, including practical session, will be on a part time basis over a period of three months on average.
