

NATIONAL EMPOWERMENT FOUNDATION (NEF) EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN - CANADA

A number of employers in Saskatchewan is recruiting Mauritian nationals for an initial period of 24 months to work as Welders – within the possible departments (rails, parts, suspension, production bays, bulkers, flat decks).

Candidates duties will be as follows: provide efficient and consistent quality welding (meaning all types and all positions of welding, including cutting with torch and plasma) and designated assemblies, consistent with drawings, procedures and specifications.

Candidates should:

- i. Be physically fit to perform the required duties
- ii. Have a recognized welding certificate, preferably Welding NC3, Advanced Arc Welding or CAP Metal Sheet Welding
- iii. Training or certification in any of the following would be an asset: mechanics, ISO 9001 Program and First Aid training
- iv. Have minimum Form IV
- v. Minimum of two years of experience
- vi. Good level of fluency in English, both written and spoken
- vii. Be willing to make a long term commitment
- viii. Aged between 20 and 45 years

REMUNERATION AND BENEFITS

- i. Selected candidates will be paid between \$23.00 to \$28.00 CAD per hour, as a starting salary, subject to skill and ability and market conditions. Compensation will also consist of an earned incentive, full benefit package as well as a retirement savings plan after three months of continuous service.
- ii. The employing companies will make deductions of approximately 33% from the employee's salary as prescribed by Canadian law (including Income Tax, Employment Insurance, etc.).
- iii. Selected candidates will be entitled to three weeks paid vacation leave per year after one year of continuous service.

Additional Information

- (i) Shortlisted candidates will go through a pre-selection and final selection exercise will be conducted by the employer.
- (ii) The employer will meet the cost of the flight for the selected candidates and 50% of the skills complementary training (if necessary).
- (iii) Employers will ensure that affordable and proper accommodation is available, which will be paid for by the employee.
- (iv) Overall costs for visa and medical examination will have to be met by the selected candidates.
