

VACANCY IN CANADA

1. Experienced Hair Stylists

The Hair Stylist will perform all types of hair services for both male (including cut and shaves) and female (cut, coloring, perms, straightening and some esthetics services such as waxing). The hair stylist may also be called upon to recommend and sell professional hair care products to their clients.

PROFILE

- Ideally in the age range of 19 to 40 years, but qualified and experienced hairdressers above this age but who are fashion forward may also be considered.
 - Minimum of 2 years' experience as hair stylist in a hair saloon,
 - Hair stylist certificate from a recognized institution,
- Completion of Secondary Education,
 - Must be fluent in English and able to converse easily with clients. Possession of IELTS certificate will be an advantage,
- Pleasant personality.

REMUNERATION AND TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

- The wage is dependent on the province where the hair stylist will work (e.g in British Columbia it is CAD 10.25 per hour, plus commissions). Deductions will be made from the employee's salary as prescribed by Canadian law (including Income Tax, Employment Insurance, etc.).
 - Employment will be on a two year contract with possibility of renewal

2. Experienced Butchers

The Butcher will cut, trim, and otherwise prepare standard cuts of meat including pork for sale at self-serve counters or according to customers' orders, grind meats and slice cooked meats using powered grinders and slicing machines, shape, lace and tie roasts and other meats and wrap them. He/she will also manage inventory, keep records of sales and determine amount, product line and freshness of products according to company and customer requirements; he/she will also supervise other butchers or meat cutters.

PROFILE

- Age range: 20-39 years,
 - 3 years of verifiable hard labour experience as butcher,
 - Completion of Secondary Education.
 - Must be Fluent in English. Possession of IELTS certificate will be an advantage.

REMUNERATION AND TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

- The wage will be in the range of CAD 12-14 per hour. Deductions will be made from the employee's salary as prescribed by Canadian law (including Income Tax, Employment Insurance, etc.).
 - Employment will be on a two year contract with possibility of renewal
 - The location of employment is in the province of Alberta
